If you think parts of this year's project are repelling, you're right!

Hold the shaft in mid-air with the pointed end against the mirror. With the opposite end between thumb and forefinger, spin the shaft (Larry prefers spinning 'towards'; David likes 'away'). A gentle touch works best for obtaining a smooth, long-lasting spin.

We've made our best efforts to carefully assemble your components to exacting specifications. But, with shipping (and maybe too much Cabernet in the workshop) some fine-tuning may be required. Sunspots and the accompanying burst of ultraviolet radiation often followed by magnetic disturbance can also cause problems.

While some bouncing and wobbling (due to harmonic oscillation) is normal (especially at slower speeds), excessive movement can be reduced by moving the rings along the shaft in very small increments. When you find the G/M-spot (the Gravitational / Magnetic point of equilibrium), you will be rewarded with long hang time.
